Decide's design combines blends clear geometries with outstanding comfort and support. These aspects are achieved via the ergonomic curve in the lumbar support and the comfortable upholstery of the seat and backrest shell. The models with medium-high and high backrests have sewn-in clamps to provide different support zones.

The unitary, fully upholstered seat and backrest shell offers excellent comfort thanks to the generous upholstery at the rear. In the version with soft padding, extra foam is added to the seat to make sitting even more pleasant.

Decide offers outstanding comfort and support due to its precision-adjustable height, elastic and ergonomically shaped backrest as well as upholstery with different support zones. The models with the innovative, three-dimensional suspension made of special high-performance steel are particularly stylish. This material, used for the first time in the furniture industry, enables the flexibility and stability required for stimu-

lating 3D movement without the need for mechanical parts. In areas where more dynamic seating is required, a rocking mechanism, whose counter pressure can be custom-adjusted via conveniently placed pull-out levers, ensures a healthy change of posture.

Design: Wilkhahn

Function

The durable conference chair fuses superior comfort with crisp design, a top quality appeal plus a wide range of models. Combined with the adjustable rocking mechanism, the shell shape of the backrest in particular means that the chair supports ergonomic dynamic sitting. Otherwise, an innovative, particularly attractive, three-dimensional rocking spring stimulates healthy movement without any mechanical parts. Three backrest heights, two frame variants, as well as four types of ring-shaped armrests and a wide range of upholstery materials ensure a wide spectrum of uses and design options for meeting spaces to boardrooms.

Base frame

Models 296/1, 296/2 and 296/3

Four-star, die-cast aluminum base, optionally coated in a silver satin finish, black or white with a textured matte finish, or high-luster or matte-polished. A DIN EN 1335-1 compliant gas lift for precision-adjustable sitting heights, black, or optionally chrome-plated when white with a textured matte finish or high-luster polished star base. Black, multipurpose glides made of plastic for all types of flooring, on request with extra felt insert (please state when ordering).

Models 296/4, 296/5 and 296/6

Five-star, die-cast aluminum base, optionally coated in a silver satin finish, black or white with a textured matte finish, or high-luster or matte-polished. A DIN EN 1335-1 compliant gas lift for precision-adjustable sitting heights, black, or optionally chrome-plated when white with a textured matte finish or high-luster polished star base. Ring-type casters with load-dependent braking as a stylish, axle-less version, made of DIN EN 12529 compliant black polyamide as the standard version for carpets; with gray polyurethane tire for hard flooring.

Both frame versions in standard with a three-dimensional rocking mechanism made of springy high-performance steel coated black or white with a textured matte finish or a silver satin finish. Lever made of steel coated black, made of white coated steel when the star base is coated white with a textured matte finish.

Optionally with a rocking mechanism with customized weight adjustment, mechanism shell made of aluminum, coated black, optionally polished when the star base is white with a textured matte finish or high-luster polish, with the top cover made of black polypropylene. Black polyamide lever for precision-adjustable height.

Seat and backrest

Unitary seat and backrest shell made of FSC-compliant, molded plywood, covered with polyurethane molded foam. Unitary covers with double saddle stitching, held in place with clamps in the cushions, replaceable. Optionally with soft padding in the seat and extra cut foam added.

Armrests

Ring-shaped armrest made of die-cast aluminum, surface the same as the frame design. Optionally with embedded armrest pad made of black, through-dyed polycarbonate, leather-covered armrest pad when the chair has fabric covers in black leather 74/99, color-matched with leather covers, or with an integrated armrest pad made of solid oak, with a natural oiled finish or stained black and varnished (please state on order).

Standards

The Decide conference chairs comply with the DIN EN 16139, DIN EN 1728 and ANSI/BIFMA X5.1 standards.
